#### NUISANCE AND BLIGHT FEES

Trash or Refuse Removal, Property Cleanup and Necessary Repairs- \$100 per hour (one hour minimum), provided that if more than two persons are assigned to the clean up or repair a property, an additional charge of \$50.00 per hour for each additional person assigned shall be charged, in addition to landfill charges and an administrative fee of \$150.

Vehicle Removal- \$100 per hour (one hour minimum), plus towing fee charged to the City by the towing company plus a \$150 administrative fee.

Mowing or Weed Abatement Fee- \$125 per person per hour (one hour minimum) or \$0.60 per one hundred square feet, whichever is greater, plus an administrative fee of \$150. All fees shall be charged once each mowing or abatement.

RENTAL PROPERTIES AND REPEAT VIOLATORS: The above fees shall be doubled for rental properties and properties with more than one violation in a 12-month period. The fees to be doubled include all of the fees listed above and the administrative fees.

Unsoftened Bulk Rural Water Users (Customers not in the City limits that consume more than 100,000 gallons of unsoftened water) shall pay 25% less than the rate billed to customers not in the city limits.

#### **ELECTRIC:**

Rider Power Cost Adjustment (Rider PCA)

This Rider is applicable to and becomes a part of each electric service contract and rate schedule in which reference is made to Rider Power Cost Adjustment (Rider PCA).

When the cost of power supply related costs and expenses incurred by the City increases above \$0.06500/kWh-sold, the rate for electric service shall be increased in accordance with the following formula:

PCA = ((P+R)/S) - B

Where:

- PCA = Power Cost Adjustment expressed in dollars per kWh- sold rounded to the nearest five decimal places
- P = Total power supply related costs and expenses expressed in dollars
- S = Energy sales expressed in kWh to which Rider PCA is to be applied
- R = Reconciliation of the cumulative over or under recovery of power supply related costs and expenses from preceding collection periods expressed in dollars and computed as the difference between the previous Rider PCA revenues collected and the power supply related costs and expenses incurred commencing January 1, 2015
- B = Power supply related costs and expenses included in the electric base rates, which is currently set at \$ 0.06500/kWh

The City shall review the Rider PCA calculation monthly. Following such Rider PCA review and calculation, the City Manager shall direct the Rider PCA to be applied, as deemed necessary to accomplish recovery of the City's power supply related costs and expenses in a timely manner.

## **Private Generation/Distributed Generation Customers**

Appropriately sized generators (as defined in K.S.A. 66-1,184) owned by customer-generators may at times either generate more electricity than the customer can consume on premises or only meet a portion or none of the customers electricity needs. During periods of time when the generator owned by the customer-generator cannot provide all of the customer's electricity needs, the electricity provided by the electric utility will be billed at the same rate as that established for similar rate class customers that do not own generation. During periods of time when the generator owned by the customer-generator produces electricity in excess of its own needs, and such excess electricity is supplied back to the electric utility, the electric utility shall compensate the customer for this excess energy at a rate that is 150% of the utility's monthly system average cost of energy per kilowatt hour, per K.S.A. 66-1,184.

**<u>SEWER</u>**-Residential Sewer charges shall be based on an average of the gross water consumption by each customer for the months of December, January and February of each year.

**In City Limits**-Minimum \$ 22.05 if water is on with no usage; an additional \$ 5.80 per 1,000 gallons of water used shall be charged.

**Outside City Limits-** Minimum \$ 38.60 with no usage. An additional \$ 10.15 per 1,000 gallons of water used shall be charged

**New Residential Customer-** shall be charged \$ 56.85 per month until there are sufficient records to calculate the average for such customer.

**Commercial Sewer Charges** -shall be based on each month's water use; at a rate of \$ 22.05 minimum and \$ 5.80 per 1,000 gallons of water usage for that month.

Septic Dump Charge- \$25 per dump

## SANITATION CHARGES:

As established by contract with Stutzman Refuse Disposal and the City of Hoisington with an additional five percent to administer the billing.

## **AMBULANCE SERVICE: PATIENT FEES**

The following fees shall be charged to each patient occupying an ambulance.

a) BLS Non-Emergency Run	\$500
b) BLS Emergency	\$700
c) ALS Non-Emergency	\$550
d) ALS Emergency	\$875
e) ALS-2 Advanced ALS	\$1,050
f) SCT- Specialty Care Transport	\$1,200

- All of the above runs receive an additional charge of \$18.00 per loaded mile
- g) For each run within or outside the City limits where a needed medical assessment, medical intervention or medication is given and the patient refuses transport, a charge of \$200.00 will be charged.

- h) For each run within or outside the City limits where no medical intervention is needed, only a physical assist is given and the patient refuses transport, a charge of \$100.00 will be charged with the following exception. A patient will be allowed three non-emergency physical assists within a year before being charged.
- For each run within or outside the City limits where a needed medical assessment, medical intervention or medication is given and the patient is then transferred to any other Emergency Medical Service the appropriate base rate in the above table will apply. (Unless a Mass Casualty situation in which a patient would fall under City of Hoisington Mass Casualty Policy).
- j) When transferring an EMS Flight Crew between any hospital and airport the base BLS Non-emergency rate, plus mileage will apply.
